CITY UPDATE:

Jon Rose provided the following City Update: restoration work has started on the Ramsdell Theatre; pier work scheduled for next summer includes refinishing top of stub pier and providing handicap access; work associated with sewer separation will be starting at Maple and First Streets; City Council has authorized discussions with the Little River Tribe relative to finding a site in Manistee for a gaming casino; NuVision will move to the building previously occupied by The Little Red Shoe House; and the paint store located in the Ramsdell Building is waiting for State barrier free access approval.
