Northwestern Savings Bank and Trust

Art Southerton of Northwestern Savings Bank and Trust presented a request for a Special Use Permit to allow additional signage for a new ATM Machine and canopy that is being built at 325 First Street. The total area of signage would be approximately 40 square feet. The canopy signs would be backlit and the ATM will have down lighting for nighttime/security purposes.


