

MANISTEE P.E.G. COMMISSION MINUTES
OCTOBER 11, 1995 - 6:00 p.m.
CITY HALL

The meeting of the Manistee P.E.G. Commission was called to order by chairperson Angela Morin. **PRESENT:** Kathy Fenstermacher, Tom Kaminski and Nancy Lemire. **ABSENT:** Bill Shales.

Welcomed were the representatives from Filer Township, Frank Balsler and Mike Bajtka.

Minutes of the August 9th meeting were read. Fenstermacher moved to accept, seconded by Balsler. The motion carried, minutes approved.

It was noted that P.E.G. did not meet in September as the By-Laws were still being drafted.

Under unfinished business, the By-Laws having been reviewed by the City Attorney, were discussed and are now ready to be presented to the City Council for their approval. Mr. Bifoss suggested we give Filer Township time to go over the draft. In November the drafted By-Laws, if approved by Filer, will be presented for the City Council.

A motion was made by Kaminski that we request from the City Council an extension of 90 days for the present operator, giving us time to have the By-Laws approved and a notice in the paper for other qualified operators to apply for this position. It was seconded by Lemire. Motion passed.

A thank you note was read from Cathy and Cliff Selkoe of Sunset Productions for the P.E.G. participation in the "Stars Across America" telethon.

A letter of complaint was read from Selkoe in regards to a violation of FCC rules by Infoprod....also a response from Carlson. A formal request was then read from Carlson for an investigation into this matter. After a lengthy discussion, Selkoe retracted his complaint and the matter was closed. A verbal complaint in reference to the technical problems while telecasting the MDA Telethon was discussed. The matter was settled.

Motion was made by Lemire to adjourn, it was seconded by Fenstermacher. Motion passed. Adjourned at 7:40 p.m. with the next meeting set for November 8, 1995.
