

**MANISTEE AREA P.E.G. COMMISSION**  
**MEETING MINUTES**  
**June 3, 1998**

A regularly scheduled meeting of the Manistee Area P.E.G. Commission was held on June 3, 1998 at 6:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers at City Hall, 70 Maple Street, Manistee, Michigan.

The June 3 meeting was opened at 6:00 p.m. by G. Carlson. A motion was made by Mencarelli and supported by Kaminski to approve the April 22 minutes. The motion passed with a 4-0 vote.

Members reviewed the edited phone survey. After discussion took place, revisions were made to the document. Mencarelli will forward revised copy to Donnan for distribution. Mencarelli, Balcer and Carlson will meet and choose a random method of selecting residents to call from Stronach, East Lake, Filer Township, Manistee Township and the City of Manistee. Calling lists of not more than 15 residents will be distributed to members at the June 24 meeting. To aid in the validity of the survey, members will conduct the survey at the end of June/first of July and then conduct another survey three to four weeks afterwards.

Donnan informed members that dates for 1999 meetings needed to be determined for the 1999 City Calendar. The PEG Commission will meet on the fourth Wednesday of each month, with exception to holidays or special events.

Mencarelli gave a presentation to representatives from local organizations. A video from the Kalamazoo public access channel was shown to those in attendance. Mencarelli noted that the PEG Commission is asking for the organization's support of Channel 2 through the form of programming. He noted that equipment will be available to check out and use for the purpose of making programs. Training sessions will be held for those persons unsure of how to operate a camcorder. Ideas for potential programming were given and the organizations interested in donating programs were asked to contact Donnan at City Hall. Discussion and questions followed the presentation.

The next regularly scheduled meeting of the PEG Commission will be held on June 24, 1998 at 6:00 pm in Council Chambers at the Manistee City Hall.

With no further discussion or business present, the meeting was adjourned.
