

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MANISTEE CITY COUNCIL – May 8, 2012

A special meeting of the Manistee City Council was called to order by her honor, Mayor Colleen Kenny on Tuesday, May 8, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers, 70 Maple Street, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

CITIZEN COMMENTS ON AGENDA RELATED ITEMS.

Ray Fortier, 367 Eleventh Street – commented on how the City is running a budget; stated that water rates come out of the people’s budget.

Paul Stewart, 101 S. Lakeshore – asked for a vote in favor of the bathhouse location; grateful for the City working with him.

CONSIDERATION OF ADOPTING THE 2012-2013 BUDGET AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN.

Under Section 7-4 of the Charter, the annual budget must be adopted before May 15 of each year. The budget has been the subject of multiple work sessions and a public hearing.

MOTION by Hornkohl, second by Marshall to adopt a resolution approving the 2012-2013 Budget and Capital Improvement Plan for the City of Manistee. Brief discussion followed.

With a roll call vote this motion passed, 4-2.
