However, since the resolution is the final authorization for the RAD conversion project, he placed it under new business to allow for discussion. President Priester opened the floor to discussion.  - The required approvals from HUD are falling into place, generally
 - Resident screen for LIHTC eligibility
 - All residents of Century Terrace and Harborview must be screened for eligibility for the LIHTC program. Commonwealth Management Corporation, and one of their vendors, have been on-site to perform the screening. The majority of our residents cooperated with the screening. However, we are working with those who did not cooperate to get the screening completed. Residents who fail to comply will have to be evicted.
