270.01 ESTABLISHMENT

Pursuant to Act 18 of the Extra Session of 1933, as amended by Act 80 of the Public Acts of 1935, Act 265 of the Public Acts of 1937 and Act 5 of the Extra Session of 1938 (M. S. A. 5.3011), a commission is hereby established in and for the City to be known as the Housing Commission. (Ord. Unno. Passed 4-5-66.)

270.02 APPOINTMENTS; COMPOSITION; TERMS; COMPENSATION; REMOVALS; VACANCIES

The Mayor of the City is hereby directed to appoint the members of the Housing Commission, with the consent and approval of the other members of the City Council. The Housing Commission shall consist of five members, each of whose term of office shall be five years. Members of the first Housing Commission shall be appointed for terms of one year, two years, three years, four years and five years, respectively, and annually thereafter one member shall be appointed for a term of five years. The members shall serve without compensation and may be removed from office by the appointing authority. Any vacancy in office shall be filled by the appointing authority for the remainder of the unexpired term. (Ord. Unno. Passed 4-5-66.)

270.03 POWERS AND DUTIES.

The Housing Commission shall have all the powers and duties vested or permitted to be vested in housing commissions by Act 18 of the Extra Session of 1933, as heretofore or hereafter amended, and any laws heretofore or hereafter enacted which are supplemental thereto, it being the intent of this chapter to vest in the Housing Commission all powers and duties permitted by law.
