

Elections

The <u>City Clerk</u> is responsible for administering all federal, state, county and local (including school) elections held in the City of Manistee. In addition, the City Clerk maintains City of Manistee voter registration records through direct access to Michigan's Qualified Voter File (QVF) system in cooperation with Michigan's Secretary of State.



Michigan election law designates the Secretary of State as Chief Election Officer with supervisory control over local election officials in the performance of their election related duties.
