- Page 6 - ⁵ Section 3-2 Annual & Special Elections – call special election 40 days in advance
 - State law requires a longer time period
- Page 7 - ⁶ Section 3-4 Nominations-Petitions – filed by the 5th Friday preceding election
 - State law requires a longer time period
- Page 7 - ⁷ Section 3-4 Nominations-Petitions – withdrawal date by Tuesday noon
 - State law requires three days after the filing deadline
- Page 7 - ⁸ Section 3-6 Board of Canvassers – *repealed*
- Page 9 - ⁹ Section 4-7 Penalties – imprisonment for not more than 90 days
 - State law states up to 93 days
- Page 9 - ¹⁰ Section 4-9 Initiative & Referendum – signatures obtained w/in 30 days of filing
 - State law allows signatures up to one year before filing
- Page 10 - ¹¹ Section 4-10 Signatures Required – not less than 15% of registered electors
 - State law states not less than 5% of qualified/registered electors
- Page 11 - ¹² Section 4-15 Submission to Electors – call a special election within 60 days
 - State law only allows elections on certain dates
- Page 12 - ¹³ Section 5-4 Appointments – be a registered elector of the City
 - State law prevents employer requiring residency
