

TRAFFIC LIGHT AT RIVER AND MAPLE STREETS

Following concerns over pedestrian safety, a traffic analysis study was completed at the intersection of River and Maple Streets. Traffic Engineers from the Spicer Group recommended adjusting the traffic signal cycle timing to create a four way all-stop and a dedicated period where pedestrians could cross at each quadrant. The signal changes were completed in June and have continued through the summer season. At this time the engineers have recommended returning the signals to normal operation to match the balance of pedestrian and vehicle movements.

The signals will be switched to normal operation on Friday, September 22.
