

## **Consumers Energy to Make Reliability Repairs, Interrupt Electric Service Early Saturday For Manistee Area Customers**

MANISTEE, Mich., April 10, 2018 – To safely make electrical repairs and improve reliability, about 4,200 Manistee area customers s will experience a 3-hour power interruption beginning early Saturday, April 14.

From approximately 2-5 a.m., 4,207 customers will be interrupted to make repairs to an electrical substation within the city of Manistee.

- The work involves replacing damaged substation equipment to improve reliability.
- Consumers Energy has mailed all customers postcards with the outage information, including a backup date, if needed, of Sunday, April 15. Customers who have signed up for the company’s automatic outage alerts are being notified in advance of the outage.
- The general area of affected customers are in portions of the city of Manistee and Filer Township, bordered by Monroe Road to the north, Manistee Lake to the east, Lake Michigan to the west and Pruess Road to the south.

Consumers Energy, Michigan’s largest energy provider, is the principal subsidiary of CMS Energy (NYSE: CMS), providing natural gas and/or electricity to 6.7 million of the state’s 10 million residents in all 68 Lower Peninsula counties.
